Centralized Databases & Data Analytics

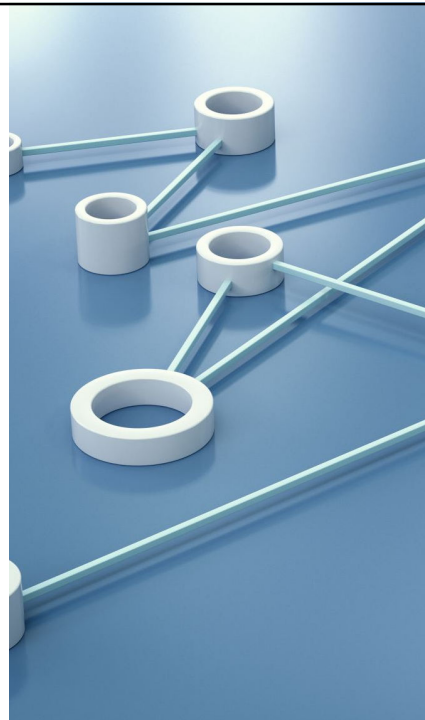
- Centralized data systems for easy access and tracking
